ABE498/AFST495 provides an introduction to Contextual methodology, which evaluates societal conditions in non-industrialized communities to better understand the uniqueness of place and time that determines the appropriateness of technology. This course uses an extensive case study from Western Africa to learn how the influences of culture, economy, education, politics and technical proficiency can affect the outcome of humanitarian engineering projects.
